GAVA President's Report

At the time of this writing the board is working through our 2018 budget. Although we don't see many changes with our operating budget, we have decisions to be made with our reserve funds. We budget each year to appropriate a certain amount of money towards our reserve fund. We allocate the money in our reserve analysis. This analysis is a planning tool that identifies certain expenditures that we will be faced with in the future. We have used this money the past couple years replacing AC units, resurfacing the pool, and replacing the roof on the clubhouse. All of which was identified in our reserve planning tool.

During our budget workshop we will discuss two major reserve projects for 2018 (storage and lawn common ground). Our storage needs have increased far greater than our current limit on available space. We have been exploring our long term needs for additional storage for some time. One of the solutions being considered is one building that would serve as maintenance, meeting, and multipurpose possibilities. We will also be discussing the poor condition of the lawn on our communal area around the clubhouse. Some of the solutions considered are expanding the sprinkler system, replacing sod, and putting in a well.

Again, it is important to note that both projects have already been identified in our reserve analysis. We will have more information pertaining to the budget at our January board meeting.

Be a Good Neighbor

FOR THE DOG OWNERS – please be a “**responsible**” pet owner and have consideration for your neighbor's property and **pick up after your dog**. Walking in the dark is no excuse to ignore your responsibility - **carry a flashlight!** This also applies to any mess left in the street - a resident could step in it during their walk or drive over it with their car or golf cart and then bring it back to their carports or garages.

A call to the City of Oldsmar code enforcement verified that “**OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REMOVING DEFECACTION WHILE WALKING THEIR ANIMALS**”, violation carries a civil penalty of an \$88 fine.

FOR THE CAT OWNERS – our community rules and regulations state that “**ALL** pets (cats included) must be on a leash when outside of the residence”. It is not fair to the neighbors to have **YOUR** cat use their flower beds as a litter box. Our community rules and regulations are posted on the Gull Aire Village website and printed in the Gull Aire Village Yellow Directory Book (Page 43). Additionally, the City of Oldsmar Code Enforcement reads, “**ANY** pet running at large and not constrained by a leash is considered a public nuisance. Owners will be responsible for payment for impounding and subject to fines. Another call to the Pinellas County Animal Control Department also verified that under Section 14-63, “no dog or cat shall run at large within the city. Any person, who has control or custody of a **CAT** or **DOG** which is running at large, is in violation of this article”. If the animal is impounded there is a \$60 - \$100 fee in addition to a fine UP TO \$500!

“**Thank you**” to all of the responsible and considerate pet owners.

Reminder from GAVA

POOL RULES

- 1. Residents are responsible for their guests.**
- 2. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.**
- 3. No lifeguard – swim at own risk**
- 4. No running, jumping or diving.**
- 5. Babies and diaper age children must wear “Swimmer” diapers.**
- 6. No food in pool or on pool wet deck. ***
- 7. No glass or animals in the fenced area. ***
- 8. Noodles and arm floats only.**
- 9. Use beach towels on chairs and lounges.**
- 10. Radios with head phones only.**
- 11. Shower before entering. ***
- 12. Pool hours are 6:30 am till pole lights are off.**
- 13. Bathing capacity: 51 persons.**
- 14. Management reserves the right to deny for just cause, the use of the pool to anyone at any time.**

SPA RULES

- 1. Maximum Water Temperature 104 F. ***
- 2. No one under age of 12 allowed in Hot Tub ***
- 3. Pregnant women, small children, people with health problems and people using alcohol, narcotics or other drugs that cause drowsiness should not use hot tub without consulting a doctor. ***
- 4. Maximum use 15 minutes. ***
