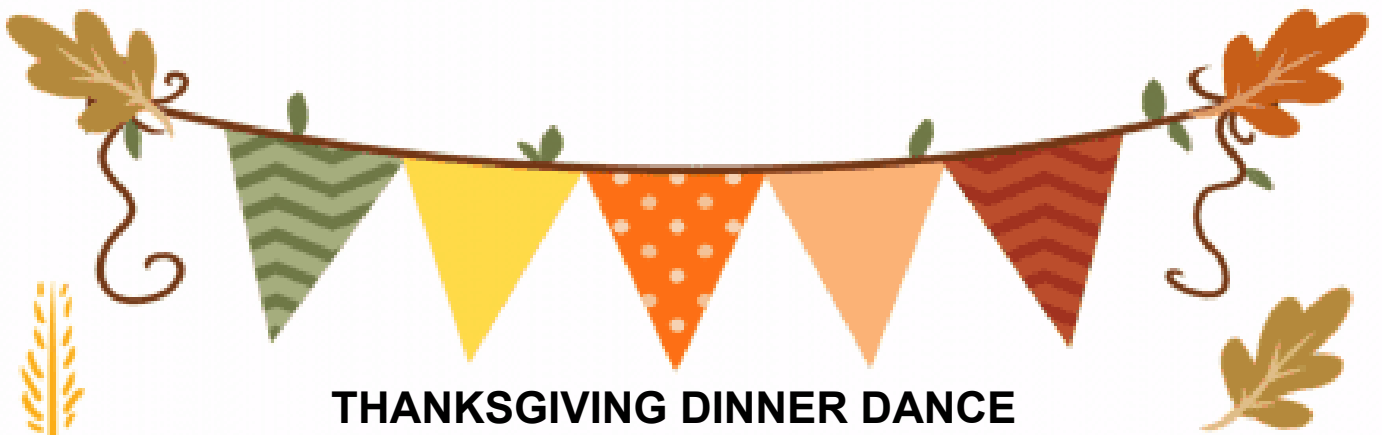

Come up and meet the people who decorate the motorcycles. Refreshments will be served at the clubhouse after the parade.



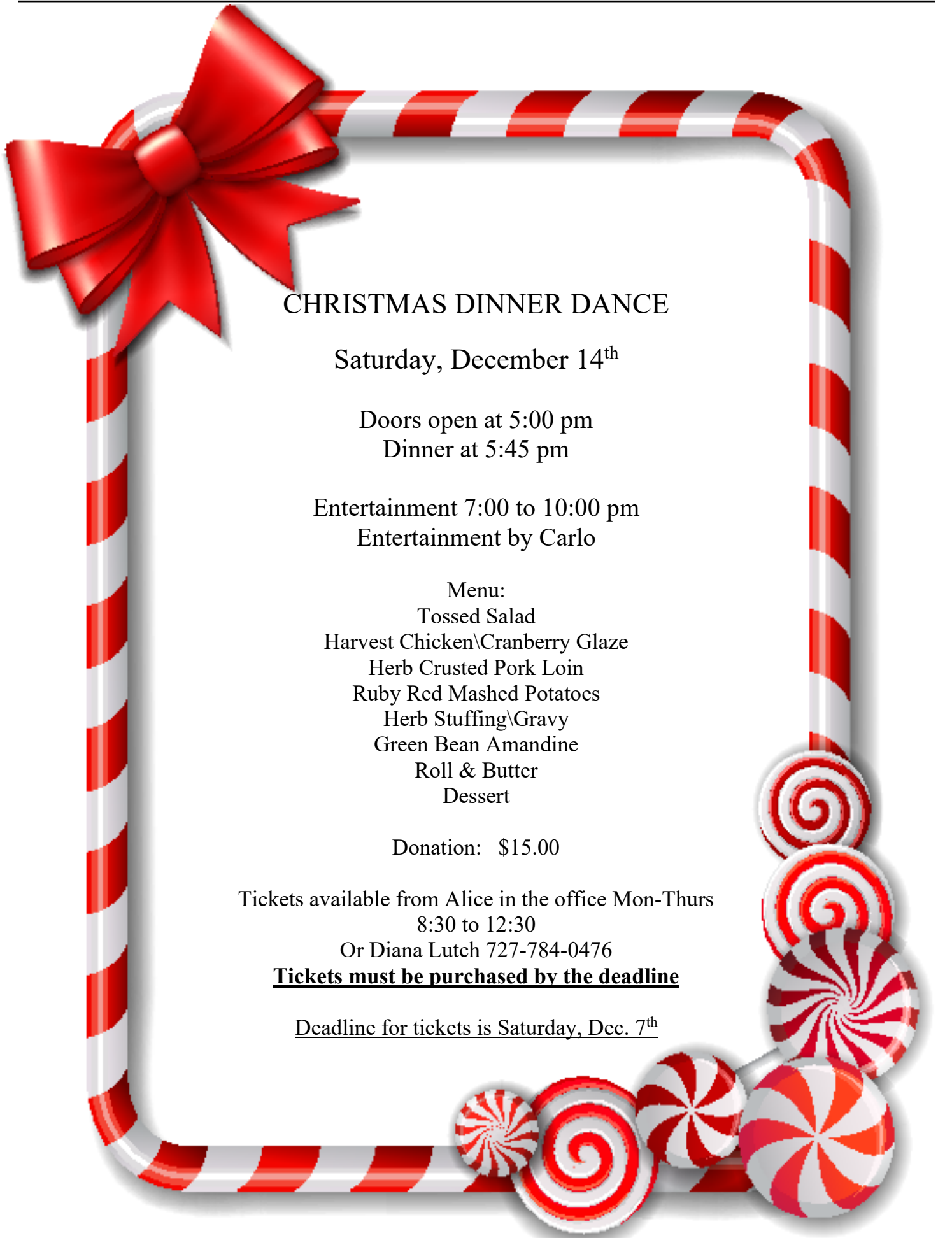
