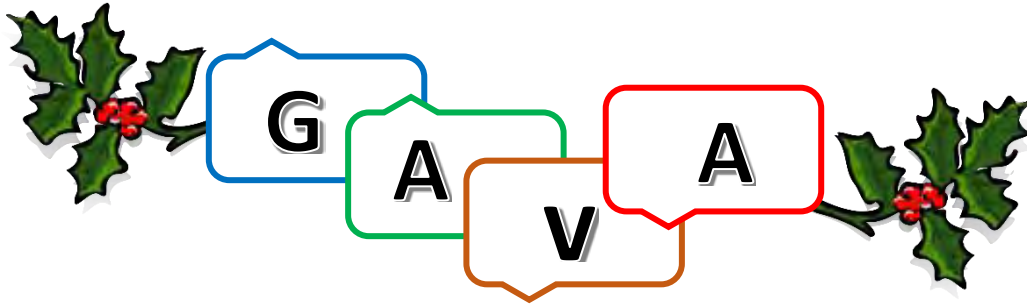

FENCES

In the front yard only a 12-inch fence in white or black is allowed on the property to keep animals off and or to protect plants. NO FENCING is allowed along sides of home

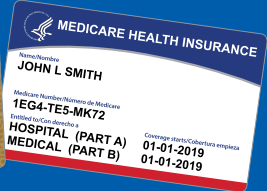
