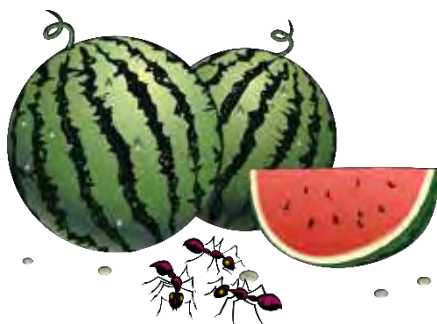

## HOA PRESIDENT'S LETTER JULY/AUGUST 2022

The pool coping is finally done. We were told in the beginning it would only take a few days to complete and as we all know it ended up taking weeks. During the final days we had issues with Clear-Tech either not showing up or showing up without notifying us. The best one was when they said they would be here on the Friday before Memorial Day and didn't show but showed up unannounced on Monday, Memorial Day and wanted us to close the pool. After a few phone calls and missed appointments the last couple of items were finally repaired and Clear-tech was done, however that was not the end. When the water level was raised back to normal and Todd attempted to start the main pump it failed. In the end, it was just a simple trick used to prime the pump and the pool was quickly back in service.

The board also finalized the project of clearing out the ditches that lead to the spillways. We had a healthy downpour shortly afterwards and the water flow was much better. Hopefully this will help stop flooding during the rainy season.

And for you pool players the pool table in the clubhouse got a face lift. The old felt was replaced and the table was leveled.

As the board reported during the May monthly meeting, we were hit all at once with major projects. We budgeted for each of them at the beginning of the fiscal year however we anticipated having them done over the period of a year, not in just two months. I bring this up only because our monthly budget report will show we are over budget in expenses for the next few months. However, by the end of the year as we continue to collect revenue we should end the year within our projected budget.

### ARCHITECTURAL GUIDELINES

With so many new residents and everyone sprucing up the outsides of their homes I thought I would just mention that we would appreciate it if you would please put your application in first before you start your projects. This saves us a lot of work in the long run. The first just to recap is the guidelines for trellis hanging.

TRELLISES ~ Must be installed in interior side yards and backyards. Backyard trellis may not exceed beyond the back property line. ~ Installation in street side yards and front yards is not permitted. ~ Must be used to support and display climbing plants. ~ A single trellis must be no larger than a 4 X 8-foot white PVC lattice sheet, supported by 2 – 4" X 4" pressure treated posts, each covered with a white PVC sleeve and cap. The lattice sheet must be installed so that the top of the trellis is no more than 5 feet above grade. The height of the posts that support the trellis must be no more than 5 1/2 feet above grade.
