HOA PRESIDENT'S LETTER

MAY 2022

It's hard to believe May 2022 is here. May is thought of as a time when spring takes hold, and everything begins to look fresh and new. It is also a great time to make improvements to your homes and yards. Be sure to check with the Architectural Committee prior to making any changes to your property. You don't want to start a project only to find out it was in violation of our rules. If you are planning on going on vacation or are a snowbird, take the time to ensure your property will survive without you. Weeds should be taken care of before you leave and any objects that could become airborne during a storm are properly put away.

Also, it is a time when people tend to relocate. If you have someone decide it would be great to live with you (seems everyone wants to move to Florida these days) and it's for over 30 days, they will need to fill out an application and submit to a background check. Applications can be picked up at the clubhouse.

I want to remind everyone if you have a concern, you would like the board to investigate it write it down and place it in the BOD mailbox in the clubhouse. Many issues can be resolved quickly and don't need to wait for a monthly meeting to receive a response. The board will investigate your concern and will act in a responsible manner to get you an answer as soon as possible. Make sure you sign your letter as we cannot respond to a letter without a name. Recently we received such a letter and sadly we cannot respond to whomever wrote it. We do not share a homeowner's violation(s) with other residents. A violation is between the violator, Ameri-Tech, the board and possibly the Compliance Committee if things are not corrected.

For those of you that are wondering about the spillway sidewalk we are waiting on a permit approval from Southwest Florida Water Management District (SWFWMD). During the first week in April, I spoke with an engineer from SWFWMD about the slow down and was told that we needed to resubmit for a permit. I sent that message to the contractor CES who is doing the project and requested they make the actual request. In the meantime, the contractor installed sod to keep people from slipping on mud or sand and getting injured.

Thank you and I hope all is well with each of you!
