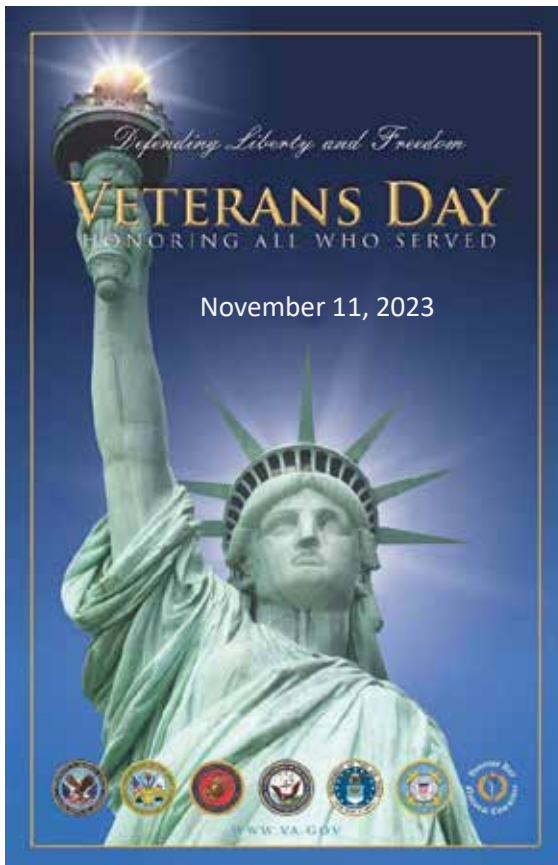

They were temporarily covered with metal to protect the clubhouse from the weather until a subcontractor could do permanent repairs. 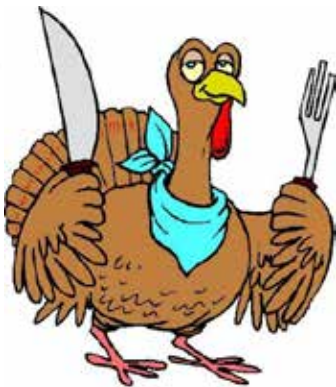

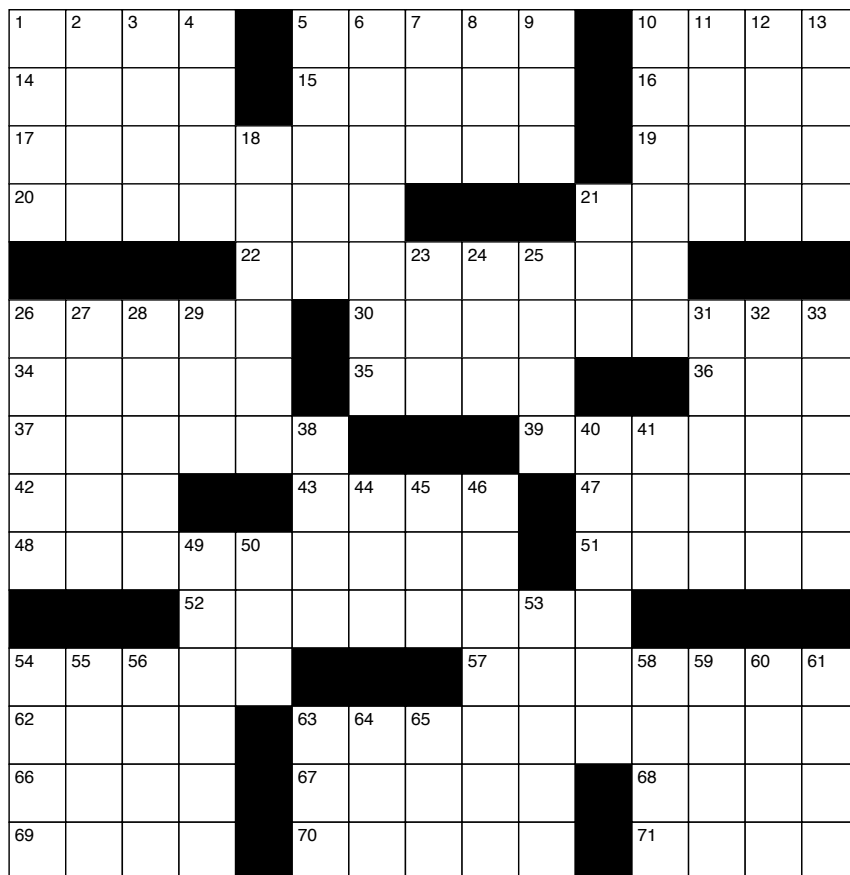
