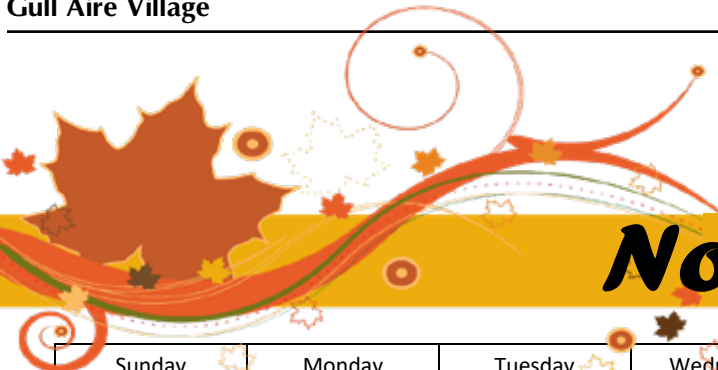

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

As we gear up for the winter months, we will begin to look at some of our existing contracts as we prepare for this fiscal year. We will be entertaining bids for such things as landscaping, lawn service, pest control, pool maintenance, etc. This is a very important exercise as we prepare for the upcoming budget.

The summer months tend to be slower when it comes to maintenance jobs. This past summer we managed to complete the following projects:

- Widened the walkway leading to the pool on the south side of the clubhouse.
- Completed replacing the roof on the clubhouse.
- Replaced the ramp on our maintenance shed.
- Strengthened the doors on our stage, studded out a more secure sliding mechanism.

We have been discussing for some time a way to get information out to the Gull Aire community as quickly as possible. This really came to my mind in the wake of hurricane Irma. What if we could get time sensitive information out to the entire community within an instant. The technology is certainly available for this to be a reality. There are many different avenues to explore. I will be looking into this more with the rest of the directors and our website team, more info to follow.

Hello Residents,

I have been a resident of Gull Aire for 7 years. During this time, I have asked many Pinellas County Deputies why no one enforces our speed limit of 15 MPH and have never received an answer the same twice.

This past week I have diligently followed all avenues to find out why everyone in Gull Aire is not held accountable for speeding. I have spoken to many PC Deputies, both in person and on the phone, spent a long time at City Hall and finally have an answer to my question of enforcing the POSTED speed limit in Gull Aire. Watching all the delivery trucks, garbage trucks and other traffic going past my house has made this a priority to get fixed.

This morning I met with the Traffic Division Officer from Pinellas County and he told me that the Speed Limit signs are legal and enforceable in our Community. Starting next week, Oct. 23, 2017, they will be patrolling our streets. First, they will give warnings to speeders, along with education on our speed limits, next after a warning is issued, if they are stopped, again, they will be issued a ticket. The more mph over the speed limit the greater the fine.

While I was speaking with Deputy Pierce, a woman came down Gull Aire blatantly going over the speed limit. When he stepped onto the roadway she didn't slow down. Finally, he almost stepped into the path of her car and she stopped. He asked her if she knew the speed limit. She either didn't or gave him the wrong answer (I was unable to hear her response). He then explained what the limit is and why she needed to follow it.

Please be kind to your neighbors and follow all posted speed limits and other signage that the City has put in our Community. Remember it could be you or your friend that may be seriously injured by a careless driver.

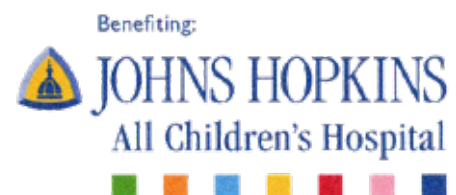

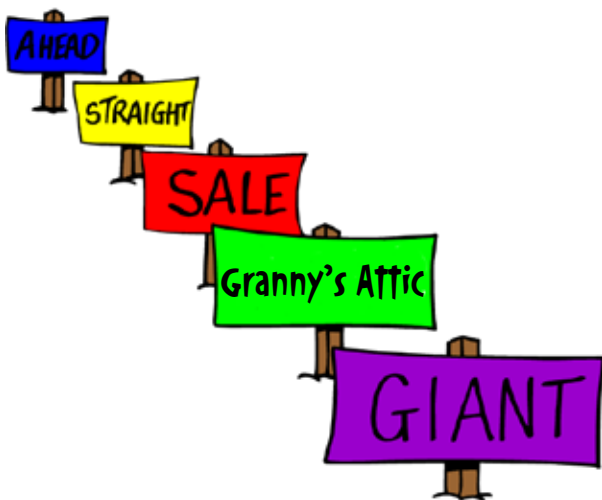
